# **ZAPORUKA FOR YOU:**

The total amount of our spending to fund the program Assistance to seriously ill children was **7,096,561.74 UAH.** 

46 children received individual assistance with the total amount of **1,501,130.28 UAH.** We purchased an expensive prosthesis for Danylo, with which he will be able to walk and live fully. In addition, we provided our beneficiaries with necessary chemotherapy, concomitant medications, and consumables that did not arrive from the public procurement. We also paid for urgent PCR tests for our beneficiaries, as this is a prerequisite for hospitalization during a pandemic.

We purchased a cytocentrifuge for the Oncohematology Department of the Western Ukrainian Specialized Children's Medical Center in Lviv. With this device, the doctors determine the disease's stage, the progress of treatment, and whether blood cells remain affected after treatment. The cost of the equipment is 462,000.00 UAH (advance payment of 138,600.00 UAH in 2020).

In the context of the project with the Renaissance Foundation, we provided the Western Ukrainian Specialized Children's Medical Center in Lviv with with the 10 litres oxygen concentrator worth **32.000.00 UAH.** 

We provided the departments in which we operate with the necessary medicines and supplies, including catheters and needles for puncture for the Lviv hospital and a set of reagents for the Cancer Institute. The costs amounted to 93,338.20 UAH.

To provide protection during the Covid-19 pandemic, we purchased rapid tests, disinfectants, and oxygen masks and, at the request of the management, conducted a bacteriological examination of the department at the Kyiv City Neurocenter. The costs amounted to **20,130.00 UAH.** 

We renovated the corridor in the Department of Hematology and Intensive Chemotherapy of the Western Ukrainian Specialized Children's Medical Center in Lviv, and repaired the filter that provides quality water for patients. Expenses in the reporting quarter were **49,892.27 UAH.** 

We continue working on the establishment of the Transplant Department at the Western Ukrainian Specialized Children's Medical Center in Lviv. In the reporting quarter, the design specifications and the estimates were completed, and the construction works began. We also started purchasing equipment for the future department. The first machine was a thawer, a device that helps prepare cells for use by the patient. It thaws both stem cells and other solutions like plasma, blood or erythromass. Expenses in the reporting quarter amounted to **2.966.357.89 UAH.** 

Our physiotherapists helped **20 children** from the Cancer Institute to undergo rehabilitation after surgery, conducting **216 sessions** with them in the physical therapy room and online. Compensation for the work of two physiotherapists amounted

49,500.00 UAH.

The team of our psychologists provided **76** children with **291** consultations and **83** parents with **241** consultations. The consultations were both individual and group. The costs of this project amounted to **129,170.00 UAH.** 

Under quarantine conditions, Zaporuka volunteers were able to hold **22** entertainment activities for children.

Two nurses of the Cancer Institute Pediatric Department lived in the apartment of the Foundation for free.

The Dacha Center became home for **32 children** and **51 parents**, as well as other family members. The cost of the project amounted to **291,167.51 UAH.**
