# **ZAPORUKA FOR YOU:**

In the context of the program "Assistance to Seriously Ill Children", we rendered assistance for the total amount of **6,950,628.66 UAH.** 

132 children received individual assistance for the total amount of 1,095,411.10 UAH. We bought a bio implant for Alina, a special plate and a skull screw for Yelyzaveta. 12 children from Kyiv and Lviv departments received Cosmegen, which we brought to Ukraine as humanitarian aid, thanks to our partners Fondazione Soleterre ONLUS. Despite the pandemic, 2 children were able to undergo the necessary examination abroad. In addition, we provided our beneficiaries with chemotherapy, concomitant medications, and consumables that did not arrive from the public procurement. We also paid for urgent PCR tests for our beneficiaries, which is obligatory for hospitalization during the pandemic.

We provided the departments in which we operate with the necessary medicines, supplies, and devices, in particular, we purchased a saw blade for the Cancer Institute, a centrifuge for the OKHMATDYT, bactericidal lamps for the ZUSDMC in Lviv, as well as Methotrexate, sternal needles, test tubes, reagents, etc. The air conditioner for the operating room was donated to the Neurosurgery. The expenses amounted to **55.609.82 UAH.** 

To provide protection during the Covid-19 pandemic, we purchased disinfectants, masks, shoe covers and gloves. The costs amounted to **48,749.00 UAH.** 

We continue working on the establishment of the Transplant Department at the Western Ukrainian Specialized Children's Medical Center in Lviv. We continued construction and repair works in the reporting quarter, which are scheduled for completion in July. We also provide the department with the necessary equipment, namely a blood cell separator worth 1,700,000.00 UAH (advance payment was made in the previous period) and a portable blood collection tube sealer at the cost of 95,000.00 UAH. We also ordered a cryobank, which would be delivered the next quarter. The doctors who will perform transplants are currently undergoing training. The expenses in the reporting quarter amounted to 2,327,383.9 UAH.

Our physiotherapists helped **15 children** hospitalized at the Cancer Institute undergo physical rehabilitation after surgery providing them with **173 sessions.** The compensation for the work of two physiotherapists amounted to **75,000.00 UAH.** 

The team of our psychologists provided **93 children** with **309 consultations** and **91 parents** with **244 consultations.** The consultations were both individual and group. The costs of this project amounted to **278,901.86 UAH.** 

Under quarantine conditions, Zaporuka volunteers organized **27 entertainment activities** for children.

Two nurses of the Cancer Institute Pediatric Department lived in the apartment of the Foundation for free.

The Dacha Center became home for **45 children** and **60 parents**, as well as other family members. The cost of the project amounted to **413,653.00 UAH.** 

The construction of the New Dacha Center is underway. During the reporting period, we continued the installation of facade panels; restored windows after the fire; painted walls and ceiling, installed vinyl flooring in family rooms and playrooms; laid tiles on the second floor; approved and ordered cabinets and washbasins for the bathrooms; found partners in the furniture industry, as well as in household appliances, some of which have already been delivered. For the Construction of the New Dacha Center works, we spent **2,462,163.58 UAH.** 

The administrative expenses of the Foundation amounted to **743,881.78 UAH.** (10 %).
