Total spending on the SUPPORT OF THE HEALTHCARE SYSTEM program amounted to **3,870,078.08 UAH.**

177 children and their family members received individual aid in the total amount of 928,821.44 UAH. For 15 children, we purchased the necessary medicines and medical supplies, including a donor's bone for Viktoria, a plate and screws for Oleksii, expensive medical supplies for Yulia'a surgery, chemotherapy for Yeva, Yulia and Kristina.

The team of our psychologists provided **64** children with **248** consultations and **91** parents with **220** consultations. The consultations were both individual and group. The costs of this project amounted to **241,785.60 UAH.**

Our physiotherapists helped **19** children from the Cancer Institute to undergo rehabilitation after surgery, conducting **226** sessions with them in the physical therapy room. After the start of the war, physiotherapists continued to work online. Compensation for the work of two physiotherapists amounted to **84,250.00 UAH.**

In partnership with Fondazione Soleterre ONLUS, **37** children were evacuated to Italy for treatment due to the war in Ukraine. The cost of the evacuation amounted to **36.467.00 UAH.**

We provided the departments in which we operate with the necessary medicines, consumables, and devices, including reagents for the National Cancer Institute and medical materials for the Institute of Neurosurgery in Kyiv and the WUSCMC in Lviv. After the start of the war, we purchased materials for urgent surgeries in the Kyiv City Hospital and the basic materials for the hospital in Kryvyi Rih: cotton wool, bandages, needles, gauze pieces, etc. The costs amounted to **477,313.28 UAH**

We purchased medical equipment for the hospitals we work with: aspirators for the Institute of Neurosurgery and for the Khmelnytsky Hospital to ensure high-quality surgery, as well as an infusion pump for chemotherapy in the Cancer Institute. The costs amounted to **130,813.00 UAH.**

We also try to create comfortable conditions for our beneficiaries who are on treatment in the departments in which we operate. In the reporting period, we continued equipping the functional diagnostics unit in the ZUSDMC, improved ventilation systems and performed the elevator maintenance in the Cancer Institute. The costs amounted to **348.536.90 UAH.**

Two junior medical workers from the Pediatric Department of the Cancer Institute lived in the Foundation's apartment for free.

On February 15, 2022, the Clinic of Pediatric Oncology and Bone Marrow Transplantation was

officially inaugurated in the ZUSDMC in Lviv. It was planned to carry out a dozen transplants a year, the first ones in spring and summer. However, the war started, and the ZUSDMC, with all available facilities, became a hub for evacuation of children for treatment abroad. As soon as possible, the first transplant will be performed on a child who cannot go abroad due to family circumstances. The costs in the reporting quarter amounted to **383,464.06 UAH.**

For two months, Dacha became a temporary home for **29** families. After the Russia's invasion of Ukraine, all families were evacuated. Unfortunately, on March 3, Dacha closed its doors till the victory day. The cost of the project in the reporting period amounted to **399,443.10 UAH**

Before the beginning of the war, the construction of a new Dacha Center was underway. During this period, we painted the walls in 4 family rooms; installed fittings and lamps in the rooms, as well as fire sensors; mounted fasteners for window blinds; conducted a test run of the elevator; ordered and already received some of the furniture. During the ongoing hostilities near Kyiv, the works were suspended, and our beneficiary's stepfather acted as a security guard of the construction site. The costs of construction and arrangement amounted to **610,378.78 UAH.**

The Foundation non-program expenses amounted to **968,797.58 UAH (19 %).**
